## **Donor Fees Policy**

<u>Purpose</u>: Establish a fee policy for all pass-thru donations. For the purposes of this document, pass-thru donations are those donations received from a donor who requests that the money go to a third party. The fee will not be applied to restricted funds received that are part of an approved fundraising effort that would be invoiced by South Middleton School District.

<u>Reason for Fee</u>: There are costs involved with the administration of this type of donation, including volunteer time and Bubbler Foundation resources. Additionally, by offering this convenient pass-thru opportunity for donors, the Bubbler Foundation could incur a significant cost for CPA attestation services if the total donations for the year exceed thresholds established by the State of Pennsylvania.

## Fees:

- a) 5% on all pass-thru donations of \$100 or more
  - Bank fees will be deducted from funds of a stock conversion, then if a pass-thru, 5% will be deducted from the amount the Bubbler Foundation receives less the bank fees.
- b) 20% on all Venture Grant (EITC) donations
- c) Incurred Fee: PayPal charges a 2.5% administrative fee on all donations

<u>Applicable Accounts</u>: Only the General Fund and Education Fund accounts will be assessed for pass-thru donations. The fee does not apply to the Bubbler Foundation Endowment or Bubbler Foundation events.

<u>Donor Request to Waive Fee:</u> For pass-thru donations other than EITC and PayPal, the donor may request the fee be waived by submitting the request in writing to the Bubbler Foundation Executive Director at <u>director.bubblerfoundation@smsd.us</u> or by mail to Bubbler Foundation, 4 Academy Street, Suite 100, Boiling Springs, PA 17007.

<u>Board Review of Waiver Request:</u> The Bubbler Foundation will review all written waiver requests. Pass-thru donations greater than \$20,000 requesting a waiver will be reviewed by the full Board of Directors and anything less will be reviewed by the Executive Committee. If a waiver decision is needed and a regularly scheduled board meeting is not within a reasonable time frame, a vote may be taken by email. Once quorum is reached, the vote will be final. An email vote is as valid as an in-person vote to waive the fee.
